

Certification

I certify that:

A. The home school:

1. Has as its primary purpose the provision of private or religious-based instruction;
2. Enrolls students between the ages of seven years and the compulsory attendance age for the district (sixteen years old is typically a district's compulsory attendance age, but you must check with your district), of which no more than four are unrelated by consanguinity or affinity in the third degree; and
3. Does not charge or receive consideration in the form of tuition, fees, or other remuneration in a genuine and fair exchange for provision of instruction.

B. As evidence the student is receiving regular instruction, I (the parent/guardian)

1. Will maintain the records required under section 167.031.2(2)(a), RSMo and will produce these records upon request, including:
 - a) A plan book, diary, or other written record indicating subjects taught and activities engaged in; and
 - b) A portfolio of samples of the student's academic work; and
 - c) A record of evaluations of the student's academic progress; or
 - d) Other written, or credible evidence equivalent to subparagraphs a., b. and c.; and
2. Will offer at least one thousand hours of instruction:
 - a) at least six hundred hours of which will be in reading, language arts, mathematics, social studies and science or academic courses that are related to the aforementioned subject areas and consonant with the student's age and ability;
 - b) At least four hundred of the six hundred hours shall occur at the regular home school location.

C. The parent/guardian and home school agrees to not pay, share, refund, or rebate any MOScholars account funds in any manner with the parent, qualified student, or any other individual within three (3) degrees of consanguinity (kinship/relation) to the qualified student.
