Employment Classification: Part time

The Spiritual Life Coordinator assists the School Principal by promoting opportunities for faith development within the Messiah School community. This position will weave whole life growth opportunities into the overall development of the student population in partnership with other Messiah church ministries. These growth opportunities are to support to the entire school community, including students, staff, and families.

Qualifications:

- Hold a bachelor's degree from an accredited school.
- Preferred: A bachelor's degree in education.
- Preferred: Lutheran trained in the teaching of the Lutheran Church – Missouri synod (LCMS) and on the roster of the LCMS.
- Prior experience working with children
- Focuses on the common unity of Christ that is shared at Messiah.
- Models the Christian faith in both professional & personal activities, integrating their life with God's grace.

Responsibilities:

- Assist in organizing and facilitating school faith-based activities rooted in discipleship, spiritual growth, and service/mission/outreach.
- Coordinate school chapels, faith family's material and the school staff devotion schedule.
- Assist in providing resources for faith integration in all areas of school life, both for students and staff.
- Develop a schoolwide memory work.
- Teach middle school religion.
- Provide personal support & counseling to students when appropriate.

Must be available on most Monday mornings during the school year.
