#### Teacher Immanuel Lutheran Church and School St. Charles, MO

I. **PURPOSE:** The teacher will instruct children enrolled at Immanuel Lutheran School to advance the spiritual, creative, emotional and social development of the children in his/her charge as well as their academic development.

## **II. PROFESSIONAL QUALIFICATIONS:**

The teacher of Immanuel Lutheran School...

- 1. Is a member of Immanuel Lutheran congregation or willing to become one.
- 2. Possesses a Lutheran Teaching Diploma, is colloquized, or is willing to meet the standards of the colloquy program.
- 3. Is certified to teach by the State of Missouri or is able to meet the standards for certification.
- 4. Has a bachelor's degree in education or a bachelor's degree in the area of teaching emphasis.
- 5. Holds membership in professional organizations and associations and actively participates in their activities.
- 6. Îs supportive of parish ministry, exhibiting interest in the total ministry of \'c.....- congregation.

# **III. PERSONAL QUALIFICATIONS:**

The teacher of Immanuel Lutheran School...

- 1. Evidences a close relationship with God through prayer, study of the Bible, and regular communion and church attendance.
- 2. Evidences a lifestyle that reflects a dynamic relationship with Jesus Christ.
- 3. Dresses and acts in accordance with established policy.
- 4. Is sensitive to the needs of others, cares about the feelings of others, is tactful and courteous, shows Christian concern for all, maintains confidences, and is respectful of others.
- 5. Is able to articulate ideas and opinions well both orally and in written form.
- 6. Is capable of performing duties assigned.
- 7. Is able to articulate the objectives of the Lutheran school, demonstrates a love for teaching children, attends, participates and is visible in the congregation and community activities.

## **IV. RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- 1. Instructs children in classroom grade level to be assigned by the principal.
- 2. Relates instruction to the Christian objectives of the school in accordance with Holy Scripture and the Lutheran confessions.
- 3. Prepares lesson plans and submits them to the principal as requested.
- 4. Evaluates and reports students' academic progress.
- 5. Keeps accurate student records such as attendance and grades.
- 6. Makes written and oral reports as needed to parents concerning the academic, social, spiritual, creative, and emotional growth of their child.
- 7. Maintains good discipline within the classroom using Christian principles of Law and Gospel.
- 8. Maintains a safe, healthy, and stimulating classroom environment.
- 9. Knows emergency procedures and can execute such procedures (fire drills, bodily fluid disposal procedures, etc.)

- 10. Supervises playground, lunchroom, corridors, dismissal, and other areas as assigned by the principal.
- 11. Assists in the planning and implementation of special school programs i.e. operettas, chapel services, National Lutheran Schools' Week events, Academic Fairs, etc. as assigned by the principal.
- 12. Serves as sponsor or coach of extracurricular programs i.e. athletic teams, student council, yearbook, etc. as assigned by the principal.
- 13. Supervises extracurricular events i.e. athletic events, concerts, field trips, class parties, etc. as assigned by the principal.
- 14. Is an active contributor to all faculty committees to which assigned.
- 15. Attends required conferences, faculty meetings, faculty devotions, and PTL meetings.
- 16. Participates in service and continuing education programs.
- 17. Is available at school during the hours specified by the principal.
- 18. Submits budget information as requested by the principal to prepare the school budget.
- 19. Cooperates with the principal in the evaluation of instruction.
- 20. Executes school policies as adopted by the CLT (church leadership team) and Head of School and implemented by the principal.
- 21. Fulfills other duties as assigned by the principal.

### V. ACCOUNT ABILITY:

The teacher is accountable to the head of school and principal who are responsible for the supervision of all teachers.

The teacher will work as a team member with all personnel of the school and church. Relationships will be characterized by loyalty and cooperation in a common ministry for Jesus Christ.

Accountability of the teacher for special assignments within the ministry of the congregation is to the board responsible for that ministry.
