- Demonstrates leadership and administrative skills
- Experience in leading, teaching and serving youth and adult ministries
- Effective in written and oral skills

• Certified and rostered as a Director of Christian Education of the Lutheran Church – Missouri Synod

#### PRIMARY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

## 1. Education:

- To lead the development, implementation and oversight of formal programs for all church supported education programs:
  - ✓ Sunday morning and mid-week education including children, youth, adult classes and VBS
  - ✓ Plan for a small group ministry that will engage members in the full benefits of fellowship, education and encouragement of the congregation
- Assist the Associate Pastor, Senior Pastor and others in teaching youth and adult confirmation ministries
- Recruit, train, support and encourage volunteers for all education programs
- Assure all educational activities sponsored by Christ the King are true to the doctrine of the Lutheran Church Missouri Synod
- Collaborate with other staff members and lay leadership to develop an integrated approach to Christian education that fosters a spirit of Christian community
- Communicate in a timely manner the availability of Bible studies through the web, church bulletin and mailed media

# 2. Youth Ministry:

- Provide oversight and support for Sr. High and Jr. High Youth leaders
- Assimilate newly confirmed and high school youth into youth ministry and congregational life responsibilities
- Encourage and promote spiritual renewal opportunities, including retreats, youth gatherings, conferences, servant events, as well as small group Bible studies
- Provide oversight to the Youth Council that is in development
- Connect with local schools and youth in conjunction with Christ the King Comfort Dog team

## 3. Adult Ministry:

- Provide oversight and encouragement to the Engaging Worship Initiative Team to define, implement and support adult ministry
- Encourage fellowship opportunities and review their effectiveness

### 4. Christian School:

- Serve as liaison between King's Kids Preschool, King's Academy and Christ the King
- Assist with chapel messages
- Provide counsel to the King's Academy School as needed
- Counsel school families as needed

### 5. Worship:

• Prepare and lead bi-monthly children's sermons

## 6. Staff Supervision:

- Support Christ the King ministry team to fulfill the mission and vision statements
- As directed by the Associate Pastor, encourage staff to set attainable goals and review progress on a quarterly basis
- Identify how their position relates to the church mission and define their mission in this light
- Provide input in hiring and dismissing of support staff

## 7. Administration:

- Attend weekly staff meetings
- Attend Council and Elder meetings as requested
- Assist, as needed, in other ministry areas in conjunction with other ministry staff
- As schedule allows, attend school events and civic events to represent the congregation and encourage members who are participating in those events
- Accept District and Synodical opportunities for service whenever possible and when not in conflict with congregational or family responsibilities
- Participate in opportunities for professional growth and encouragement
- A balanced ministry/personal life

Responsibilities will be added or deleted as the ministry goals and vision grows and changes.
