- Create a positive, structured, and encouraging classroom environment that supports creative risk-taking
- Integrate creativity, critical thinking, reflection and self-expression into instruction
- Manage classroom materials and maintain an organized art space
- Assess student growth using formative and summative methods and provide constructive feedback
- Collaborate with classroom teachers and staff as needed
- Support school events, displays, or art showcases as appropriate
- Differentiate instruction to meet diverse learning needs
